



15.28.092 Political Signs. Notwithstanding any other provisions in this chapter, the following provisions shall apply to the size, placement and type of political signs.

1. Political election signs shall be permitted only on private property without a permit in any zoning district.
2. Political election signs shall not be placed within the public right-of-way.
3. Such signs shall not be located within fifteen (15) feet of a street intersection.
4. Such signs shall not exceed sixteen (16) feet in sign area.
5. Banner signs, portable signs, and signs attached to fences or walls, constructed in accordance with the Grayslake Fence Ordinance are prohibited.
6. Such signs shall not be attached to light posts, utility poles or trees.
7. Such signs shall not be internally illuminated.
8. Window signs shall not exceed two square feet per sign, not to exceed a total of sixteen (16) square feet per premises or twenty-five (25) percent window coverage. Further window signs must be erected on the inside surface of the window, may be erected sixty (60) days prior to said election and shall be removed within five days following said election.
9. Such signs shall not include flashing lights, mechanically moving parts or noise emissions.
10. Unless political election signs include on its face the name of the person or organization responsible for such signs, the owner of the private property on which such sign is located shall be deemed responsible for said sign.
11. Such signs in violation of the section shall be removed by property owner within twenty-four (24) hours of notification.
12. Such signs located within the right-of-way will be removed by the village without notice.
